

Alert notice: the FGDR warns the public about the actions of fraudsters who are disseminating false information and creating fake websites to promote financial products.

- Fraudulent certificates bearing the letterhead and signature of the Fonds de Garantie des Dépôts et de Résolution (FGDR) may be sent, falsely indicating to recipients that the FGDR guarantees the investments being offered.
 - ➤ The FGDR is in no way responsible for these certificates. It is strongly advised that all recipients of such communications do not respond and refrain from making any financial transactions or sharing any personal information.
- Fraudulent websites may replicate the design of the official FGDR site, using a similar URL to disseminate false information about the FGDR's guarantees and the financial institutions it covers.

 - ► IAny other address, even if it differs by a single letter, is a fraudulent site. The official FGDR website includes a search engine to verify if a banking or financial institution is covered by one of the four FGDR guarantees.
