- Fraudulent emails using the letterhead and signature of the Fonds de Garantie des Dépôts et de Résolution (FGDR) and signed by individuals claiming to be FGDR employees are currently circulating. These emails ask recipients to provide their personal or banking information., through the fake website “fgdr.net,” which provides a fake contact address: “contact@fgdr.net.”
- The FGDR is in no way responsible for these communications. Anyone who receives such emails is strongly advised not to respond to them and not to make any bank payment or provide any information whatsoever.
- **Do not visit the “fgdr.net” website. Do not send emails to “contact@fgdr.net.”**
